Alumni Achievements Chronicle: A Legacy of Excellence

The alumni of NLIU Bhopal have exhibited exceptional achievements across various legal domains. Noteworthy successes include several alumni clearing the Advocates on Record examination in 2023, such as Niti Richhariya, Shivani Vij, Hiresh Choudhary, Ankur Mishra, and Yash S Vijay. Furthermore, graduates from different batches have excelled in exams like the Madhya Pradesh Civil Judge Exams of 2019 and 2023, Delhi Judicial Services Exam of 2023, UPSC Civil Services Examination of 2022, UP Judicial Services Exam of 2022, and Punjab Judicial Services Exam of 2023. The alumni network has also witnessed remarkable promotions, with individuals like Nayantara Kutty, Chirayu Chandani, and Kaustubh Verma rising to Partner positions in reputed law firms, while Albin George Thomas and Ravi Dubey achieved promotions to Equity Partner roles. Additionally, alumni received recognition in prestigious legal rankings such as Forbes Legal Powerlist, 2021, Legal Era Leading Lawyers Ranking, 2023, AsiaLaw Ranking, 2023, and IFLR1000 Asia Pacific Rankings, 2023. These accomplished legal professionals have also been acknowledged with awards, including the "Business Excellence and Innovative Best Practices Academia Award" bestowed upon Kriti Sharma, and the "Asia Pacific Regional Forum Scholarship" awarded to Kuruvila M Jacob.





Placement Success

In 2023, our students who pursued B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) excelled in placements, with 45 students securing positions in prestigious firms like Cyril Amarchand Mangaldas, Shardul Amarchand Mangaldas, Trilegal, Varahe Analytics, and more. Notable names among the successful candidates include Abhijeet Kashyap and Arunima Shrivastava. The meticulous placement schedule, featuring PPO offers from July 2021 to July 2022, Day Zero from August 4 to 6, 2022, and Rolling Placements from September 2022 to April 2023, contributed to an impressive 85% placement rate for the 53 participating students, reflecting the institute's commitment to nurturing successful legal careers.

For the MCLIS students, out of the 58 students who participated in placements, 53 are successfully placed, with salaries ranging from 5.5 Lakhs to 17.00 Lakhs Per Annum, and a median salary of around 9.0 Lakhs Per Annum. Top hiring organizations for MCLIS students include Shell India (8 placements), KPMG India (7 placements), Deloitte India (7 placements), E&Y GDS (10 placements), and more. These statistics underscore NLIU's excellence in shaping legal and cyber law professionals, making it a leading institution in the field.





NLIU Triumphs: Moot Courts, Negotiation and Sports Achievements

NLIU takes pride in the consistent demonstration of exceptional legal acumen and advocacy skills by our students. In

the Moot Court arena during the academic year 2022-2023, their achievements, including securing top positions, Best Memorial, and Best Speaker Awards in prestigious competitions like the Dr. MVVS Murthy 3rd National Moot Court Competition, highlight their commendable dedication. Recognition also extends to Negotiation Competitions, with victories in the 1st Law College Dehradun National Mediation and 1st VGU R.K. Rastogi Memorial National Negotiation Competition. Notably, our students achieved the Runners Up position in the Med-Arb Format at the Concordat 3.0, the 3rd National ADR Competition held from 15th to 17th December. Shambhavi Anand, Yashottma Singh, and Yohann Titus Mathew represented NLIU in this competition. These remarkable successes are a testament to the rigorous training and commitment of our students,









reflecting NLIU's dedication to fostering legal excellence. Congratulations to our participants and the entire NLIU community for these outstanding achievements.
