## INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDER

1. Attention of the tenderer is directed to the conditions of tender and general conditions of the contract of NLIU. The Bidder must read the terms & conditions before submission of the tender.
2. The bidders should quote their lowest rates which means the highest discount based upon the Terms and Conditions forming part of the tender document.
3. In case, the date of submission/opening of tenders happens to be a holiday, the tenders shall be received/opened on the next working day.
4. The right to accept a bid will rest with the Registrar, National Law Institute University, Bhopal.
5. The bid should remain valid for a period of **120 days** from the date of opening. In case your offer has a different validity period that should be clearly mentioned in the quotation. The validity period may also be extended without change in bid prices, if required on a mutually agreed basis only.
6. The price of the goods quoted should be FOR NLIU BHOPAL inclusive of all applicable taxes (GST etc.), packing, forwarding, insurance, and other local services required for delivery, at NLIU BHOPAL.
7. The bidders should quote their offer/rates in clear terms without ambiguity.
8. The rates should be quoted both in figures and words. In case of any discrepancy between the rates in figures and in words, the rate in words will be accepted as correct.
9. Each bidder shall submit only one bid. A bidder, who submits more than one bid, shall be disqualified and considered non-responsive
10. The books must be new and in good condition Damaged or old books will not be accepted and will be returned at your cost.
11. Only the latest edition of books will be accepted.
12. The price must be as per the latest catalog of the publisher only. A certificate to the effect that "Latest publisher's prices have been charged is to be furnished with the bill.
13. The price proof of foreign books from the publisher's website/catalog must be submitted.
14. Conversion rate of the Reserve Bank of India will be considered for the conversion of foreign currency to Indian currency on the date of invoice i.e. actual date of sending the consignment to the library
15. If the Indian editions of foreign books are available, then it should be supplied instead of foreign editions.
16. Printed price of books should not be tampered with by labels or any other means. In such cases, books will not be accepted and original price proof from publishers needs to be produced in the Library of NLIU BHOPAL.
17. Pirated or photocopies of books should not be supplied and in case such a book is found, then the purchase order will be canceled automatically, and the firm will be blacklisted forever.



18. The bills must be supplied in triplicate. There will be no interest liability in any case. The bill should be in alphabetical order of author and must contain ISBN number of the book.
19. Only ordered books (as specified in our list) will be accepted and Library, NLIU BHOPAL in no way remain responsible for out-of-ordered books.
20. If the price of a book exceeds more than Rs 25000, written permission from the competent authority is to be taken before the supply of the book.
21. It is compulsory to supply no less than 50% of the ordered books within given time. After the due date, books will be not accepted.
22. Preferences will be given to those supplying maximum discounts (for Indian and foreign publishers' books separately).
23. Quantity of items may increase or decrease or may be cancelled up to any extent.
24. Any clarification/query regarding the purchase order should be sought from the Library within five (05) days of receipt of the order.
25. Any book that appears at more than one place in the given order (Duplicate entry) shall be taken only once.
26. The books will be delivered at Gyan Mandir Library, NLIU BHOPAL campus at no additional cost for Packing, forwarding, freight etc. by the supplier.
27. In case, the vendor fails to comply with the terms & conditions, the Institute may terminate the contract without assigning any reason and is free to dispose of the waste paper items in such a manner as may be deemed appropriate.
28. The order will stand cancelled if it is not supplied within, the stipulated time period i.e. maximum of 04 weeks for Indian publications and a maximum of 06 weeks for foreign publications, or within the time extension if any, from the date of purchase order positively at your own cost at Library, NLIU BHOPAL No pre-payment will be made by the Institute in this regard.
29. The invoice should contain the billing date and Library reference number for each item, along with the publisher's catalog/price proof duly stamped and signed.
30. University Library will prepare a comparison chart against offered discounted price for each title of book which were uploaded by the bidder to identify lowest offered price (L1) and that book will be ordered with the respective L1 bidder.
31. Partial bid may be awarded to tenderer based on L1 for respective titles/Books.
32. Dispatch Documents: Information relating to the mode of dispatch should be e-mailed/faxed/phone/courier/speed post to the Library, National Law Institute University, Kerwa Dam Road, Bhopal 462044.
33. Original dispatch documents are to be forwarded to the Library by way of recorded delivery i.e. Registered post/speed post in the above-mentioned address only.
34. Preparation of Bills: The Bill should be prepared preferably in the same order separately for Indian books and foreign books as items listed in the Purchase Order. Addressed to Finance Officer, National Law Institute University, Kerwa Dam Road, Bhopal 462044. The Supplier should submit the pre-receipted bill in triplicate mentioning the purchase order



number, date and deliver challan number along with supporting documents if any, such as Xerox copy to the publisher current catalogue price proof duly stamped and signed by the supplier, concerned copy of original import invoices etc. as per University book purchase rule.

35. Price Certificate: A price certificate required to be incorporated in each and every bill stating that the price charged in this Invoice/Bill is /are the correct catalogue price to the publisher's/Authorized distributor's price. The books supplied are not remaindered titles. In case there is special price offers by the publishers, the same should be communicated to the Library and billed accordingly
36. Any Statutory variation in the rate of taxes/duties is to be borne by the purchaser. /GST rates as applicable on the date shall be payable by the successful bidders directly to the seller at the time of taking delivery of materials. In order to avoid the imposition of penalty, the amount deposited by the successful bidder towards taxes and duties will be immediately deposited with the concerned tax authorities without waiting for actual delivery.
37. The Earnest Money received shall be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders without any interest, after the finalization of the party. The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of the successful tenderer shall be refunded after the submission of the performance bank guarantee.
38. **In the case of a successful bidder, the bidder has to furnish a performance bank guarantee of 05% of the awarded contract value for the entire duration of defect liability period/extended period. 1. The bidder shall have to submit self-certified copies of valid PAN, GST registration.
2. All Rates, Prices, Amounts and Sums quoted by the bidder shall be in INR only. The language used throughout shall be English.
3. All Rates, Amounts & Sums shall have to be quoted in both in figures and words. If the rate quoted in words does not tally with the rate quoted in figures, then the rate which corresponds to the lesser amount shall be considered.
4. Tender must be submitted with the rates for all the items of work involved and any incomplete tender documents will not be considered. The items for which the rates are not quoted will be considered as 'Zero' & the agency shall complete that item of work without any claim.
5. No alteration shall be made by the party in the quotation and no conditional tender will be entertained. Tenders with a split rate will not be considered.
6. The bid shall remain valid for a period of **120 days** from the date of opening of the bid.
