- Authors are informed not to resort to plagiarism and that the NLIU follows zero-tolerance against plagiarism.
 - Not more than 2 authors are allowed for one article.
 - All the contributions are to be in Times New Roman with a font size of 12. Headings should be in capital letters with a font size 16 and subheadings should be in Font size 14. Further, the footnotes shall be in font size 10. A line spacing of 1.15 for the main text and 1.0 for the footnotes is to be followed.
 - A one-line gap must be maintained between headings and paragraphs. All paragraphs should commence with a one-inch indent.
 - All writing should conform to the Oxford University Standard for Citation of Legal Authorities (OSCOLA), 4th Edition.
 - The subject of the email shall be as follows – "Submission for Volume XVI, | Name of the Author/Authors – Title of Submission"
 - All submissions shall be sent to ilr@nliu.ac.in in .doc or .docx format with file named as – "[Name of Author/Authors] –Title of Submission"
