2. Candidates are required to bring one set of following self-attested documents (photocopy) along with originals for the purpose of verification and finalization of admission process:
 - I. Mark Sheet of 10th Examination.
 - II. Passing Certificate of 10th Class.
 - III. Mark Sheet of 12th Examination.
 - IV. Passing Certificate of 12th Class.
 - V. Mark Sheet of Graduation or its equivalent (Original and Photocopy) (For LL.M. and MCLIS candidates only)
 - VI. Seven copies of recent color passport size photographs in white shirt, black tie and black coat with red background as this photograph will be used for printing on the marksheet of the student of NLIU, Bhopal.
 - VII. Transfer Certificate in original.

- VIII. Migration Certificate in original.
 - IX. Character Certificate in original.
 - X. Affidavit of intervening period in original, if there is a gap of one or more years between the qualifying examination and the year 2026 (The document should be prepared or printed on a ₹100 non-judicial stamp paper).
 - XI. Government-issued valid card, such as Aadhaar Card, Driving License, Voter ID card, etc.
 - XII. Original Admit Card (CLAT-2026) for B.A.LL.B. (Hons.), B.Sc.LL.B. (Hons.) [Cyber Security] and LL.M. Courses and original admit card for MCLIS Course.
 - XIII. CLAT Score Card, if applicable.
 - XIV. Valid EWS Certificate, issued by the competent authority, if applicable.
 - XV. Original Caste Certificate, issued by the competent authority, if applicable.
 - XVI. Original Domicile Certificate, issued by the competent authority, in case of M.P. State and J&K Residents, if applicable.
 - XVII. Person with Disability Certificate, satisfying the norms of reservation in this category, issued by the competent authority, if applicable.
 - XVIII. **Blue color permanent pen marker.**
 - XIX. Original copy of the fund transfer certificate/receipt in the bank account of NLIU, Bhopal.
3. In case of NRI/NRI Sponsored category candidates, the following documents are required to be submitted:
- I. Affidavit by Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) for Admission of Candidates under the NRI Sponsored Category Seats.
 - II. Copy of Certificate of being an NRI or a certificate of the relationship with the Sponsor to meet the requirements of NRI/NRI Sponsored Rules (see www.nliu.ac.in) for the rules relating to NRI/NRI Sponsored).
 - III. Letter from Embassy (NRI Certificate of the Candidate/Parents to be submitted in the Letterhead of the Embassy Office).
 - IV. Letter from Embassy (PIO/OCI Certificate of the Sponsor to be submitted in the Letterhead of the Embassy Office).*
- *OCI Card holders may submit a valid copy of OCI Card, proof of residence (valid copy of passport) in lieu of embassy letter for taking admission in the B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) & B.Sc.LL.B. (Hons.) [Cyber Security] Courses under NRI Sponsored Category. All other*

documents listed above and mentioned in the NRI/NRI Sponsored Rules 2026-27 are to be submitted.

- VIII. Original copy of certificate issued by the bank, mentioning the rate of exchange US\$ and ₹ at the time date of bank transaction.

1. I shall obey in word and spirit the rules and regulations of the Hostel and any amendments thereof as laid down by the NLIU Ordinance, 2023.
2. I shall at all times maintain the discipline and decorum of the Hostel and I will strictly follow the attendance rule and will mark my attendance at the hostel gate every day without fail within the stipulated time.
